

CROYDON POSTAL BOWLS CLUB

POST OFFICE PAIRS

This competition was originally set up in 1973 by Bob Goodwin (Delivery Office Manager at Thornton Heath) and Walter Reed (Assistant Head Postmaster at Croydon), and is organised by the Post Office Sports & Social Club, to encourage mixed bowling.

The competition is open to mixed pairs from:

- clubs affiliated to the Borough of Croydon Bowling Association;
- clubs affiliated to the Sutton & District Bowling Association;
- members of the Croydon Post Office Sports & Social Club;
- clubs invited by the Croydon Postal Bowls Club.

The winners receive a cheque and the Walter Reed Shield; the runners-up receive a cheque and the Bob Goodwin Bowl. There are also prizes for 3rd and 4th place.

The competition is played according to the EBA rules, as published in the Crystal Mark book.

Additional rules re. Substitutes:

- one substitute is allowed per match and may play as lead or skip.
- one of the original pair must play in every round.
